She has extensive experience in areas of medical and health law, insurance, bioethics, human research ethics and personal injuries. Mayada has recently acted and advised on such matters as medical negligence, health practitioner regulation, health service delivery, electronic health records, privacy, clinical governance and guardianship matters. Mayada also worked in-house as Director of Legal Services with the Australian Medical Association (Vic), and as Legal Counsel with WorkSafe Victoria. She is a legal member of the Committee of the Medico-Legal Society of Victoria.

Ms Mayada Dib will speak about the AHPRA/PSR process and mandatory reporting from a legal perspective. She will provide practical advice and strategies about how best to handle mandatory reports and notifications, as well as investigations from third party providers such as Medicare, thereby minimising distress for the health professionals involved.
